


Visit to Gurudwara and Augharanath Temple






Empowering Future Innovators: Guest Talk by Stemrobo Technologies

क्या आप भी इस बात का मजाक उड़ाते हैं। दरअसल जिसे लोग मजाक समझते हैं, वह सिखों के गौरव और उनके शौर्य की कहानी है। इस बात का संबंध 18वीं शताब्दी से है। जब भारत पर फारस के शाह नादिर शाह ने आक्रमण किया था। मार्च 1739 में नादिर शाह की सेना दिल्ली पहुँची और उसके बाद नरसंहार हुआ। अनिगनत लोगों को मार डाला गया और महिलाओं को बंदी बना लिया गया, तो सिखों ने उन पर हमला करने और महिलाओं को आजाद करवाने की योजना तैयार की। सिखों ने रात में ही 12 बजे उनके शिविरों में जाने का फैसला किया। इस दौरान वे गोरिल्ला रणनीति अपनाकर 12:00 बजे हमला करके महिलाओं को नादिर शाह के चंगुल से बचाते थे। लेकिन समय के साथ-साथ, कुछ लोगों ने "12 बज गए" को मजाक के रूप में इस्तेमाल करना शुरू कर दिया।

सिखों ने हिंदू बहू बेटियों को छुड़वाने का अभियान चालू कर दिया। ये एक तरह से सिखों का गोरिल्ला अभियान बन गया था। मुस्लिम अब्दाली के इस आतंक से बचने के लिए महिलाओं ने सिखों के सामने अपनी रक्षा के लिए अपने हाथ फैलाए थे। इसके बाद सिख जरनैल बाबा जस्सा सिंह और आहलूवालिया ने रात को 12 बजे अटैक किया था। ऐसा कहा जाता है कि इस अटैक के जिरए सिक्खों ने 2200 लड़िकयों को बचाया था और उन्हें उनके घरों तक सुरक्षित पहुँचा दिया था। इसके बाद सिख जरनैल 12 बजे ही अत्याचार के खिलाफ मोर्चा खोलते थे। इस अभियान के बाद मुगलों में सिक्खों को लेकर दहशत फैल गई थी। अब्दाली जैसे आक्रांताओं में ये खौफ फैल गया कि '12 बज गए हैं, सावधान हो जाओ.' क्योंकि जब 12 बजते थे, सिख बहू-बेटियों की रक्षा करने के लिए निकल जाया करते थे। आशा है कि अब आप सभी सिखों के इतिहास के बारे में जान गए होंगे और उनके 12:00 का मजाक नहीं उड़ाएँगे।




